- Consulting and engaging with interested parties, this includes staff, contractors, clients, suppliers and others who may be affected by our operations.
- Ensure the provision and maintenance of plant, equipment and systems of work are safe.
- Ensure tasks given to employees are within their skills, knowledge and ability.
- Provide specific information, instruction, training and supervision to personnel who have particular health and safety responsibilities.
- Ensure technical competence is maintained through the provision of refresher training as appropriate.
- Consult and include the participation of workers, to support with the development health & safety management system.
- Make suitable and sufficient assessment of the risks to the health and safety of employees, arising from or in connection with the organisation's activities.
- Establish, provide and maintain safe methods of work for all activities where needed.

All employees are expected to co-operate and assist in the implementation of this policy, whilst ensuring that their own works, so far as is reasonably possible, are carried out without risk to themselves or others.
